

- d. Whereas on Friday the 6th day of May, 2021, prior to the DISEC meeting, I personally led a delegation from Fafaa 100.3 Fm Dzodze to the office of the district commander, Anloga
- e. That the meeting lasted for one and half hours, where we have narrated details of our outfit's collaborations with his predecessor, DSP Earnest Dorkunor and the Divisional Commander now DCOP Alexander Amenyio, the gains achieved in the public interest, and the need to foster cooperation with our outfit to continue the good deeds of his predecessors.
- f. That he again refused to respond to text messages to him dated 9th May, 2021, of his need to clarify the allegations being levelled against the police by the public. Text messages sent to his personal contact number – 0244868398 registered as : THOMAS YAW AGBANYO
- g. On Friday the 21st May, 2021, Madam Rejoice Hoenyefia claimed she reported her daughter whom she suspects of being pregnant while camped by the pastors of the said Jerusalem Church -Woe, but DSP Agbanyo justified the illegal abortion of her daughter, he rather referred them to do another pregnancy test which proves negative.
- h. That on Tuesday the 25th day of May, 2021, the Duamenefa Foundation of Fafaa 100.3 fm called DSP Agbanyo (off air) to respond to the allegations by Madam Rejoice Hoenyefia. The phone call interview was met with resistance to Fafaa Fm's interrogation officer and the commander concluded thus " DO NOT CALL BACK AGAIN " (This is on our off air interviews record)
- i. That Fafaa 100.3 fm further seeks clarifications from the Regional Director of the National Commission for Civic Education, Mr. Ken Kponor on the role of the police in matters of alleged confessed illegal abortion to the Anloga police, as claimed by Madam Hoenyefia. Mr Kponor educated that the police is expected to detained the lady for further investigation to unravel the criminality of the act and the actors
- j. That during the on air education from the NCCE , Regional Director in this regard , Fafaa Fm have no means of reaching the commander than to openly called on the DSP for his right of response anytime he deemed convenient (since he instructively says we should not call him again) .
- k. That on the 24th day of June 2021, Madam Gladys Ahuma, a trader of Anyanui together with Hon. Jambo Kushime, the Assembly man of Anyanui, petitioned the Duamenefa Foundation of Fafaa 100.3 Fm Dzodze to investigate the allegations of threat to life of Madam Ahuma by an alleged Fetish Priest called Hunua Kudzo Gbeti with contact number - 0244186753 who allegedly claimed "she was sold to him to be killed".
- l. According to the assemblyman, he accompanied the woman to make an official complaint to the police at Anloga. He further alleges that the Police Commander DSP Agbanyo took over the investigation but later called to tell them that the Police cannot continue the investigations to arrest the alleged fetish priest because, he the commander was threaten by the Juju man.
- m. That Fafaa Fm reported the news of insecurity of Madam Gladys Ahuma and other allegations against the Anloga Police Commander in the public domain to the District Chief Executive of Anloga, Hon. Seth Yormewu.
- n. That the DCE assured our outfits he would conduct his findings and revert in due course.
- o. That our outfit carried an independence investigation and discovered the location of the said fetish priest who is allegedly threatening the life of the market woman, but where do we report this matter if the commander is alleged to be involved in conflicts of interest with the allege criminals
